4. Selection Process

- A. Completed applications are due to the Community Recreation Center at 30875 Rancho Vista Road or to DayCamp@TemeculaCA.gov by **Friday, May 17th, 2019**.
 - Mail cannot be received at this address, so please drop off your application or email it to the email address listed above.
- B. You will be notified via email if you are selected as a Jr. Counselor by May 24th, 2019. Those accepted into the program will then be required to attend the training dates and times scheduled (TBD). Check your email each day for important updates.
- C. *Applicants must be age 15 by Monday, June 10th, 2019.*

5. Responsibilities

- A. Jr. Counselors will assist the staff at the Summer Day Camp program.
- B. Duties are: supervising camp participants in athletic games, crafts, camp activities, and field trips. Duties also are: assisting with the setup/breakdown of activities, crafts, and games.
- C. Jr. Counselors will be assigned to programs of interest whenever possible. However, Jr. Counselors must be flexible and work in needed areas of the facility.
- D. Jr. Counselors must inform their parents regarding their activities, work schedules, and transportation needs.
- E. Jr. Counselors are responsible for keeping a daily record of their hours volunteered.
- F. Jr. Counselors are expected to fulfill their commitment to this program, as they are an important part of its success.

6. Notes

- A. Please note that this is an unpaid volunteer position. Jr. Counselors are at-will volunteers and can be dismissed from the program at any time.
- B. Jr. Counselors can receive the necessary signatures for any school-related forms by bringing the forms to the Camp Director at the conclusion of the program (unless other arrangements have been made prior).

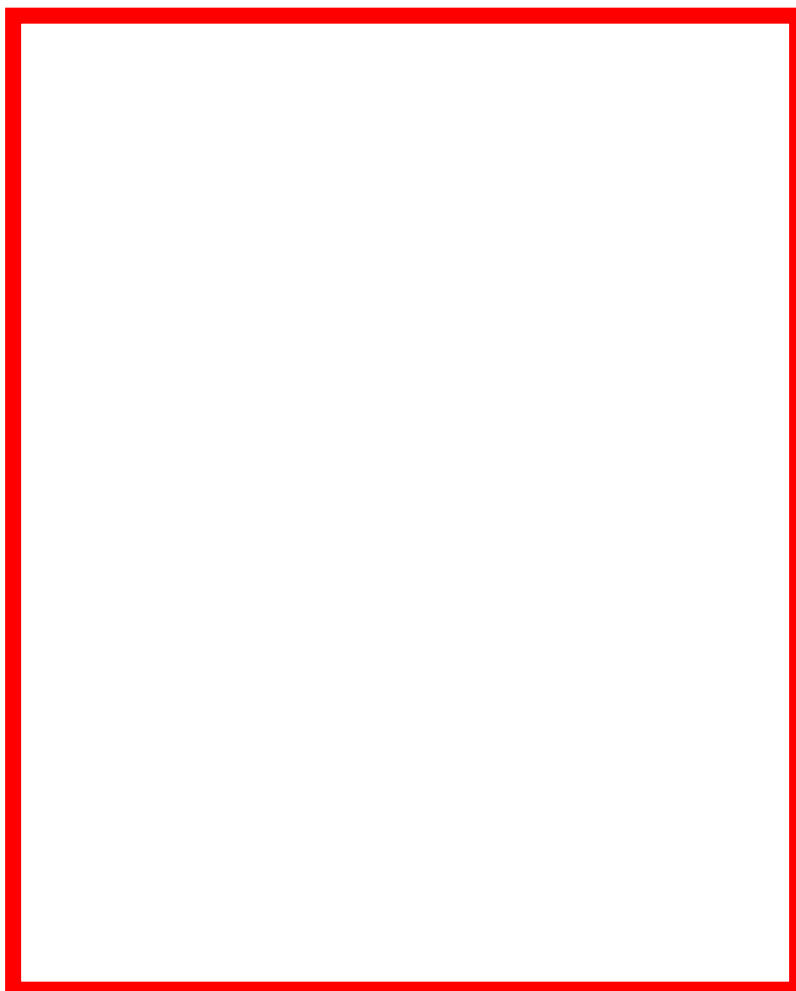
