Code of Conduct

•Online completion of an annual membership for each participant is required for all participants. In addition, non-Temecula residents will be charged an additional \$5.00/day of use. See staff for more information.
No membership = No ride.

•All participants are required wear the appropriate safety gear while using the facility. This includes: helmet, elbow pads, and knee pads. Please bring your own safety gear. *Patrons not wearing the appropriate safety gear will not be permitted to ride.*

•Closed-toed shoes are required. *Violators will be asked to change shoes or leave.*

•Due to safety concerns, persons wishing to assist a participant in the riding areas must have a current Skate Park membership on file.

•All forms of graffiti, tagging, or other means of defacing City property is prohibited. *Such activity may result in closure of the facility.*

•Only non-motorized devices are permitted.

•Food and drink may not be consumed in the riding areas. *Participants eating/drinking will be asked to finish the items outside of the riding areas.*

•The last time to check in is 30 minutes prior to closing. Staff will end the session approximately 5 minutes before closing to allow for time to transition.

•The City of Temecula reserves the right to change the schedule as necessary.

•NO profanity.
1st offense = Warning
2nd offense = 10 minute suspension
3rd offense = Suspension for rest of day

•Bullying.
1st offense = Warning
2nd offense = 10 minute suspension
3rd offense = Suspension for rest of day

•NO throwing of equipment (scooters, skate boards, helmets, knee pads, elbow pads, etc.).
1st offense = Warning
2nd offense = 10 minute suspension
3rd offense = Suspension for rest of day

Management reserves the right to extend suspensions based on the severity of the violation.

The Temecula Skate Park offers the ultimate scooter, BMX, skateboarding and in-line skating experience. The park consists of a competition 60-foot diameter bowl with ramp entry. A 10-foot wide apron connects the upper bowl with a street plaza skate area. The street plaza has a pyramid, fun box, curbs, ramps, stairs, and a hand rail.

The park is staffed and open to the public for a different session each day, 7 days a week, with the exception of some holidays and events. The facility is lighted for night use and can accommodate a maximum capacity of 30 participants at one time.
