I will wash my hands with soap and water. I will scrub my whole hands when I wash.



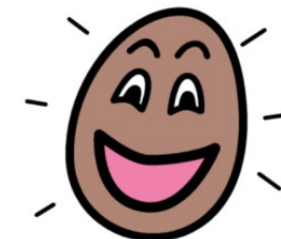
I will cover my cough and sneeze so I don't spread my germs.
