- Stay Camp will be offered on weekdays from 10:00am - 1:00pm PST. Stay Camp will be offered in 2-week sessions.
- The supplies and materials needed for the Stay Camp activities in clearly marked bags/boxes will be mailed to your residence before sessions begin, and sessions will cost just a fraction of our normal pricing.

Summer Stay Camp

The biggest problem with working from home is actually WORKING from home. Does it feel like your house is shrinking? Your kids are home all day (and demanding your attention). You're responsible for their education, but you're also trying get your own work done. Suddenly it feels like everyone is living on top of each other. For most kids (especially for those without siblings), this time is a very lonely experience. They're missing their friends from school. They're missing their friends from camp. They miss their routines.

We know that nothing can replace kids actually BEING at camp (and out of the house), but in the meantime, we've come up with a plan to give your kids a social life again, while also giving you a little room. So, welcome to Summer Stay Camp - a virtual "camp!" This is not another "sit-and-watch" program. Your camper will have face-to-face interactions with familiar staff and fellow campers during virtual activities, games, and crafts. Best of all - ALL necessary supplies and materials will be mailed to your home before your camper's session begins!

That means, no hunting down a long, complicated supply lists! Simply log your camper onto a device using the unique Zoom link/password sent to you after registration, hand your camper their "Stay Camp" box, and we'll take care of the rest! We've maximized interaction for campers, but minimized the work for parents. While this program does not replace childcare, it will offer a unique experience for your child to socialize and keep busy for a couple of hours each weekday! Campers will need a device with video and microphone capabilities.
